# **BURSARY APPLICATION 2022/2023**

#### Purpose of the Western Quebec Career Centre Bursary


The Western Quebec Career Centre (WQCC) understands the challenges that face students often impact their success. One of these challenges is the lack of financial support for the basic material requirements to complete a program. Our program costs range from \$200 to over \$800. Costs may include workbooks, software, safety equipment and uniforms. For 2022/2023 we will offer one bursary per program to a student from a Western Quebec School Board high school or adult education centre.

#### **Applicant Eligibility**

- 1. Must include a reference from a teacher or administrator.
- 2. Must be at least 16 years old before the start of the program.
- 3. Must be a resident of Quebec.
- 4. Must have attended a Western Quebec School Board, school or centre in 2021/2022.
- 5. Must meet the academic pre-requisites for the program of choice.
- 6. Must have registered for a program at WQCC starting in 2022/2023.
- 7. Must be prepared to attend a meeting to discuss the application.
- 8. Must submit a completed application form by the deadline of June 3, 2022.

#### **Bursary Details**

- 1. The bursary covers program costs as per program requirements (see page 2).
- 2. The bursary will cover the full length of the program.
- 3. To retain the bursary, students must remain in good standing while registered at WQCC.
- 4. Students who receive a bursary, if asked to leave the program, must return unused materials.
- 5. Programs are subject to numbers and will only start if they meet the minimum number of 20 registered students.
- 6. Students may choose to pay for additional text books, tools, and materials not listed in their program requirements.
- 7. APPLICATION DEADLINE: June 3, 2022.
- 8. Successful applicants will be informed by JUNE 30, 2022.

**SECRETARIAL STUDIES: up to \$500** 

WELDING & FITTING: up to \$800
