

## **New York City Trip**



D'Arcy McGee High School is organizing a trip to New York City from October 17-19, 2024. Senior students can sign up with Ms. Furlotte and Ms. Piercey starting May 15-June 7, there will be 50 spots available. We encourage students to consider this opportunity early to reserve their participation. Once the above teachers have received the necessary number of participants, we will communicate with the tour company who will be accepting registrations through a portal sign-up where parents can split the payment of this trip over the summer.

- Organized tour with Educatour, a Canadian and International Tour Company.
- The itinerary is planned by the tour company and supervised by teachers and a tour guide; travel will be by a motor coach bus that will stay with the group for the trip.
- The cost of the trip depends on the number of students participating: 50 students, the cost will be an estimated cost of **\$900**.
- Included in the price: motor coach travel, hotel for two nights, breakfast at the hotel, gratuities for bus driver and the guide, a Broadway Show (to be determined), one dinner at a restaurant before the show, entrance to MOMA (museum).
- Other meals are covered by students at their expense.
- Trip Insurance is mandatory and is provided by the tour company for an additional charge.
- Students must sign up with their intention of participating in this trip before teachers accept the contract with the company. If we have enough students, we will accept the tour company's proposal and open the company portal which will allow students to register on a first-come-first serve basis.
